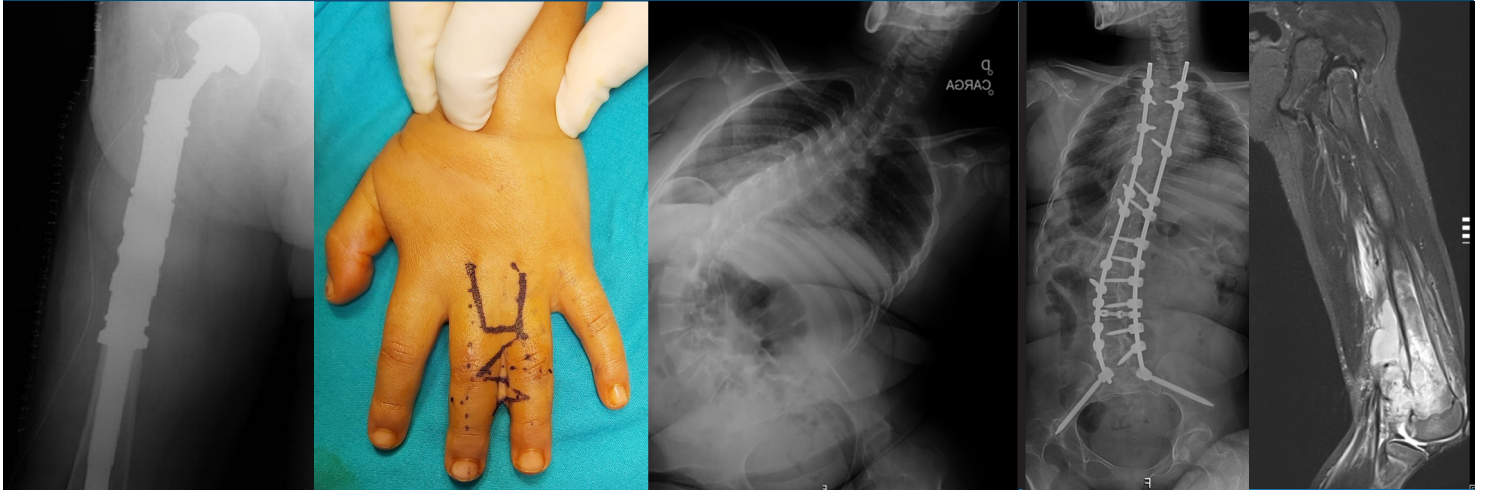

It is a pleasure to invite you to the 9th EPOS BAT Instructional Course Trilogy Part III – Basic II Course, which will be held in Vienna, at the Speising Hospital on 25-27 November 2026.

EPOS BAT (Basic, Advanced & Traumatology) Trilogy is a cornerstone of the EPOS Educational Programme and includes three consecutive events (Basic I, Trauma, and Basic II Courses), meeting the requirements of the core curriculum in Paediatric Orthopaedics set by the European Federation of National Associations of Orthopaedics and Traumatology (EFORT) and European Board of Orthopaedics and Traumatology (EBOT).

Participants may start the EPOS BAT Trilogy at Basic I, Trauma, or Basic II courses and will obtain the Trilogy Diploma once they successfully complete these three courses. Since May 2011, almost 700 physicians from 60 countries have completed the BAT Trilogy.

This Part III of the BAT Trilogy is aimed at residents who want to improve their understanding of Children's Orthopaedics and also at all orthopaedic surgeons who wish to update their knowledge.

This course will provide a greater understanding of children's orthopaedics via a problem-solving approach to the diagnosis and management of neuro-orthopaedics, spine, upper limb, tumours and musculoskeletal infections in children, based on the faculty's experience and best current evidence.

The faculty includes internationally renowned experts in paediatric orthopaedics from all over Europe, who will provide theoretical lectures, engage in debates, share pearls on surgical techniques, and dynamise case discussions. Acknowledging that treatment innovations often arise from collaboration between industry and clinicians, this course also includes industry workshops, which will contribute to enhancing participants' educational experience.

We are looking forward to welcoming you to the Orthopaedic Hospital Speising in Vienna in November 2026. We will do our utmost to exceed your expectations!
