Dear Colleagues,

One of the goals of European Paediatric Orthopaedic Society (EPOS) is to be leaders in education for Paediatric Orthopaedics in Europe. The EPOS Educational Committee has set up the BAT (Basic, Advanced & Traumatology) educational program. 
