Development of medical industry from 2020 to 2030

As early as next year the implementation of the state programme Development of pharmaceutical and medical industry over the period from 2013 to 2020 will be completed. Now strategy for the next period until 2030 is being prepared. Implementation of the Healthcare national project will give a further boost to the development of the industry, since it will lead to a long-term demand for Russian medical products. What support do producers of medical products and pharmaceuticals in traumatology and orthopedics need in the near future? How can a high-performance export-oriented medical industry be created in Russia? What role does foreign business have in Russian traumatology and orthopedics? Answers to these and other questions will be provided by speakers at the session.

Providing prosthetic and orthopedic products to disabled people and people with occupational injuries Problems and solutions

Problems related to occupational injuries are still very much relevant. At the moment, the system of provision of medical care to injured individuals has not been properly established and requires involvement of the Ministry of Labour and the Social Insurance Fund. Participants in the round table discussion will talk on issues related to provision of care to disabled people and individuals with occupational injuries.

Issues to be discussed:

1. Uninterrupted rehabilitation of patients after limb amputation
2. Development and adoption of national standards to ensure individual approach to the prescription of prosthetic and orthopedic products
3. Assessment of the current level of rehabilitation as the main criterion in the prescription of highly functional POPs.
4. Use of electronic certificates to improve the system providing disabled people with technical means of rehabilitation

Meeting of the biomedical defense issues section of the State Duma Defense Committee expert council

According to the decision of V. Shamanov, a Duma member and Chairman of the Russian State Duma Defense Committee, a regular meeting of the biomedical and biological defense issues section of the committee expert council will be held within the framework of the Forum.

Participants in the meeting will discuss issues related to organization of provision of medical care of all types and levels, ranging from first aid rendered to patients at the venue of incidence (injury) to legislative regulation-related issues. The meeting also provides for discussion of issues related to further development of domestic production of medical equipment and implants, use of innovations and latest scientific achievements, import substitution and localization of production in an industry that is critically important for our country, its defense and security.

The meeting will be attended by State Duma members, representatives of the Ministry of Defense, Ministry of Healthcare, Ministry of Internal Affairs, Ministry of Industry and Trade, FMBA of the Russian Federation, Federal National Guard Agency, Ministry of Emergency Situations, as well as representatives of domestic producers of medical products and equipment, public organizations and independent experts.

Today, the government is considering creation of a state medical venture fund; private initiatives to support medical development are being brought to life, and a system of public-private partnerships is evolving.

What private and public support initiatives are the most effective for traumatology and orthopedics? What is the role of private investment? Which innovative projects in traumatology and orthopedics need support above all?

2. What funding is available to scientists and startappers working on innovative products in traumatology and orthopedics? Where should they turn to to get the funding?

On Legal Risks Related to Work of Traumatologists and Clinics

A field meeting of the working group on the development of a unified Federal information system on patients with implants in traumatology and orthopedics

The development of orthopedics in Russia is gaining momentum, yet there are factors that potentially could take the industry to a new level. One of these factors is the creation of a Russian registry of patients with implants. Such registries, now in use in more than 100 countries, are extremely beneficial for the development of orthopedics on an international scale.

Discussion of issues related to the creation of the registry is perfectly in line with the policy of the Russian Healthcare Ministry that has recently adopted measure aimed at the development of the digital medical base. Moreover, creation of such a registry will solve the problem of promoting Russian manufacturers of implants on the domestic market.

1. Need for information system of patients with implants in traumatology and orthopedics
 2. International practices of maintaining registers of patients with implanted products
 3. Legal issues related to the register of patients with implants
